The 5th Week of Lent Year C highlights God's promise of new beginnings. In the first reading, God speaks through Isaiah, telling the people that God will do something new. 
# **HOW TO SIGN UP FOR MINISTRIES ON OUR WEBSITE:** Here are the

1. Register with your name and email and create a password
