CHURCH COUNCIL NEWS:



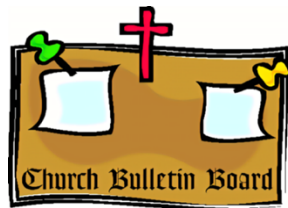
