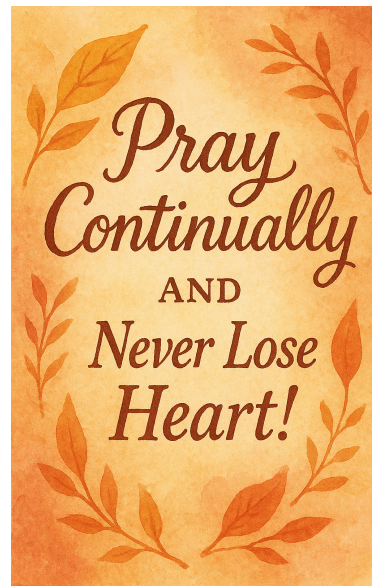

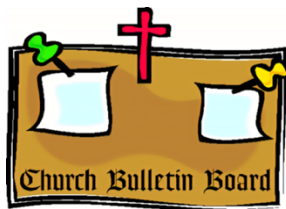


Centering Prayer/Meditation and Labyrinth
