First Week of Lent

Deuteronomy 26:4-10; Ps 91; Romans 10:8-13; Luke 4:1-13



As we begin the season of Lent, we listen to Jesus' temptations in the wilderness – the tempter's "offers" and Jesus' response. The tempter wants us to think **only** of ourselves – "*me-ness*." Through prayer, Jesus is strong enough to look beyond hunger, powerlessness, and testing God. During this Lent, we are cultivating Compassion, a virtue that calls us to "*we-ness*": to deeply care for others as well as

ourselves, woven with our Love of God.

"Compassion asks us to go where it hurts, to enter places of pain, to share in brokenness, fear, confusion, and anguish. Compassion challenges us to cry out with those in misery, to mourn with those who are lonely, to weep with those in tears. Compassion requires us to be weak with the weak, vulnerable with the vulnerable, and powerless with the powerless. Compassion means full immersion in the condition of being human." 


Centering Prayer/Meditation and Labyrinth
