Second Sunday of Easter (Cycle A) The Feast of Divine Mercy

Readings: Acts 2:42–47; Psalm 118:2–4, 13–15, 22–24; 1 Peter 1:3–9; John 20:19–31



Reflection

The disciples are gathered behind locked doors, afraid—yet Jesus comes into their midst not with judgment, but with peace: “Peace be with you.” He does not hide his wounds; instead, he reveals them as signs of love that has endured suffering and death. The Resurrection does not erase wounds—it transforms them. The risen Christ still bears them, now as sacred signs of love. Likewise, our own wounds—personal, communal, even spiritual—can become places where grace enters and compassion grows. Today we remember that faith is not the absence of doubt or difficulty, but the courage to trust that love is stronger than fear, and life stronger than death. *Where are the “locked doors” in my life right now? How is Jesus speaking “peace” into my life today? How might my wounds become sources of compassion for others?*

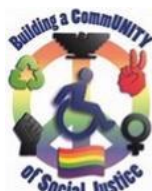

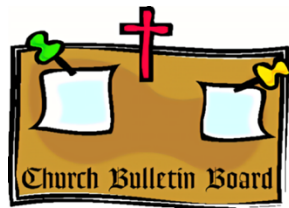

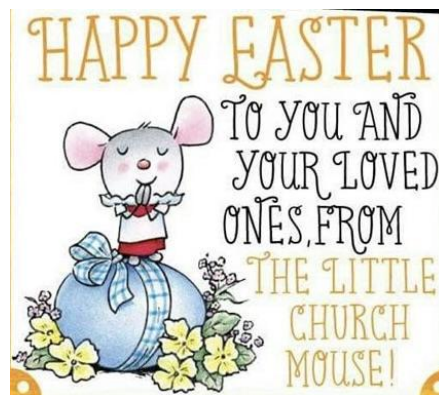
