Compensation is negotiable. Contact: Bishop Kae at 720-232-1562

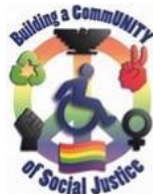

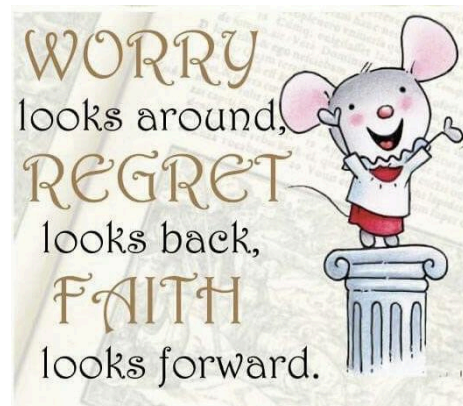
