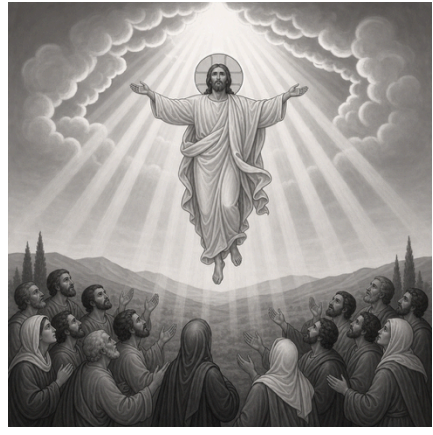

Here is a brief ad if you know someone to send it to or can cut it out and post it on bulletin boards. Word of mouth is usually most effective! Thanks a bunch.

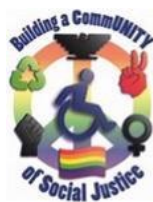
----- Seeking Accompanist – Guitar or Piano

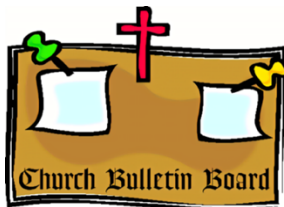

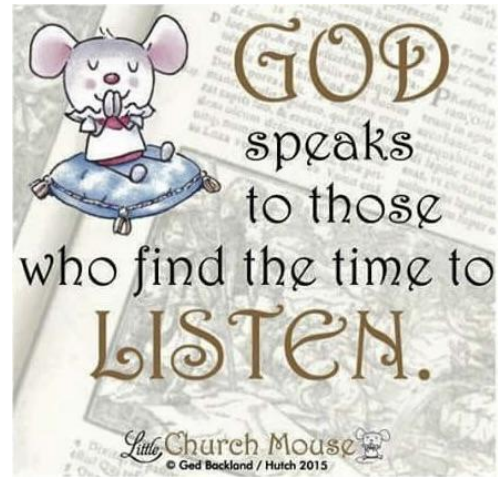
