

Thank you for your food and school supply donations.


This year's fundraiser for COB is Sept. 14. But that is not the only way to raise money for this community!

HOW TO SIGN UP FOR MINISTRIES ON OUR WEBSITE: Here are the steps to the new ministry signup process (which is through our COB website):


- 1. Register with your name and email and create a password
