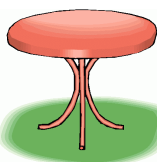

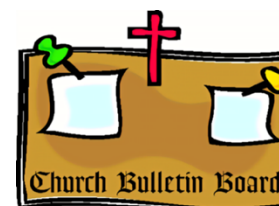

1. Register with your name and email and create a password at <https://churchofthebeloved-ecc.org/register/>
