From Life of the Beloved, by Henri Nouwen

From all eternity, long before you were born and became part of history, you existed in God's heart ...The eyes of love had seen you as precious, as of infinite beauty, as of eternal value. Your preciousness, uniqueness and individuality are not given to you by those who you meet in clock-time, but by the One who has chosen you with an everlasting love.

The Beloved One says: I have called you by name, from the very beginning. You are mine and I am yours. You are my Beloved, on you my favor rests. I molded you in the depths of the earth and knitted you together in your mother's womb. I carved you in the palms of my hands and hide you in the shadow of my embrace. I look at you with infinite tenderness and care for you with a care more intimate than that of a mother for her child. I have counted every hair on your head and guide you at every step. Wherever you go, I go with you, and wherever you rest, I keep watch. I will give you food that will satisfy all your hunger and drink that will quench all your thirst. I will not hide my face from you. You know me as your own as I know you as my own. You belong to me. I am your father, your mother, your brother, your sister, your lover and your spouse ... yes, even your child ...Wherever you are I will be. Nothing will ever separate us. We are one.

Margaret, and our clergy.

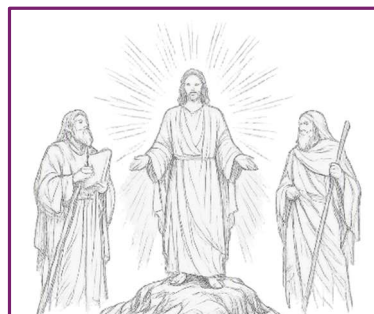
Listening Team
