The 25th Week of Ordinary Time

Readings: Isaiah 55: 6-9; Psalm 145: 2-3, 8-9, 17-18;

Philippians 1: 20c-24, 27a; Matthew 20: 1-16.

As I preside at Mass for the last time as Associate Pastor of Church of the Beloved, this week's readings could not be more fitting. They express the heart of what I have discovered in my own journey of faith as I have walked with you these years—and all that I have hoped to teach, preach, and live:

God is love. We are invited into that love and called to be that love in the world, always discovering new ways of recognizing God present with us, within us, and throughout all creation.

The readings speak of a God whose generosity exceeds our imagining: gracious and merciful, slow to anger and rich in kindness; always ready to welcome, include, and care for all. So high above our ways are God's ways! There are no limits to the depth or breadth of God's love.

This faith has been reflected to me a thousandfold in your lives and in the beloved community we share.

So, as Paul wrote to the Church at Phillipi, I leave you these words: "Conduct yourselves, then, in a way worthy of the Gospel of Christ." Whether I come and see you myself (***which I will!***) or hear about you from a distance (***which I will!***), may it always be said that you are standing firm in one spirit, in unity for the faith of the Gospel."

May each of you be blessed—and continue to be a blessing.
