

Readings: Amos 6:1a, 4-7; Psalm 146:7, 8-9, 9-10; 1 Timothy 6:11-16; Luke 16:19-31



In this week's gospel, Jesus tells of a man named Lazarus—not the friend He raised from the dead, but another Lazarus: poor, sick, and covered in sores, ignored by most people—especially the rich man who passed him daily. Who do we walk past without seeing? Who remains unnoticed in our daily comings and goings? Open the eyes of our hearts, Lord Jesus, to see the unseen as you do—with the eyes of love.
