The Feast of the Epiphany of the Lord

Readings: Isaiah 60:1-6; Psalm 72:1-2, 7-8, 10-11, 12-13.; Ephesians 3:2-3a, 5-6; Matthew 2:1-12



This week we celebrate the feast of the Epiphany. The word “Epiphany” comes from the Greek “epiphainein”, which means “*to reveal*.” The gospel tells of the visit of the 3 Magi, wise ones from distant lands to whom Christ is revealed—not only as the expected “Messiah” of the Hebrew people, but as the presence of God come for all the world. On the feast Epiphany, we reflect on the many ways God *reveals* Godself to us today. How wonderful it is then, that this Epiphany, we celebrate the 50th Anniversary of the Ordination to Priesthood of Fr. Frank Quintanna who has been serving and revealing the presence of God in Christ to so many, for so long! Congratulations, Fr. 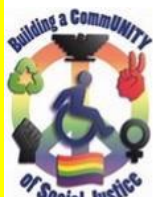

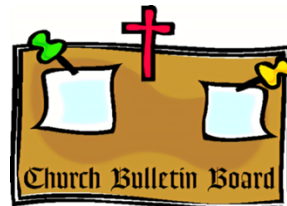
