The 16th Week of Ordinary Time

Readings: Wisdom 12:13, 16-19 ; Romans 8:26-27; Matthew 13:24-30



This week's Gospel gives us one of Jesus' most hopeful stories—the parable of the wheat and the weeds. The servants want to pull up the weeds, but the farmer says, “No. Let them both grow together.” It is a surprising invitation to patience, trust, and hope. This week we might ask ourselves: *Where am I being invited to be more patient-with others, our world, or with myself? How might I become more aware of the quiet, hidden ways grace is already at work? Where do I need to trust the Gardener and leave room for new life to grow?*

Sunday July 19th 7:00AM in person and on zoom.

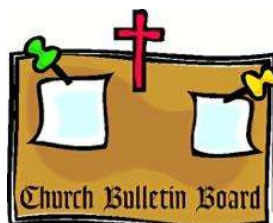

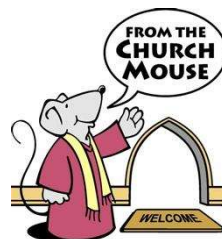
